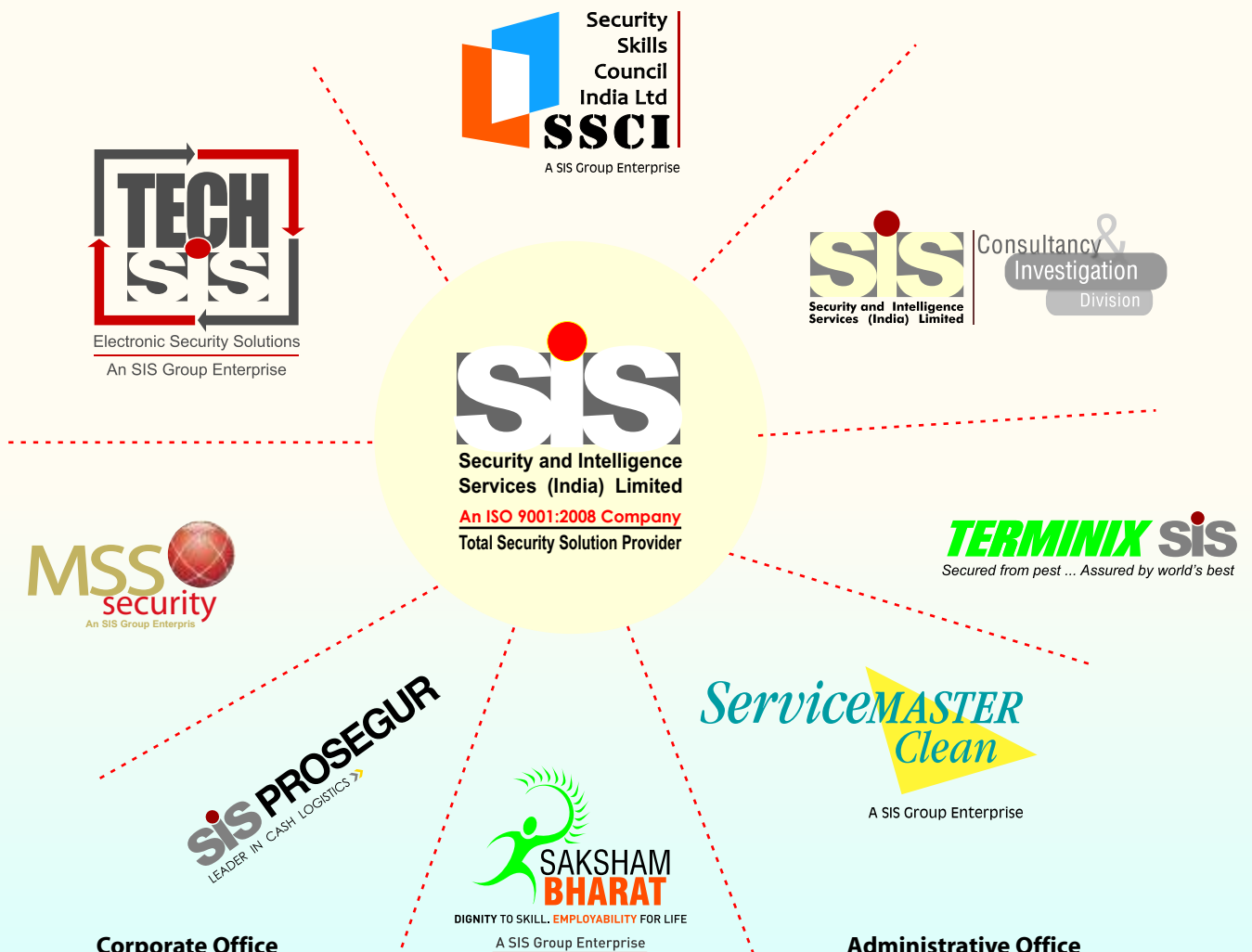

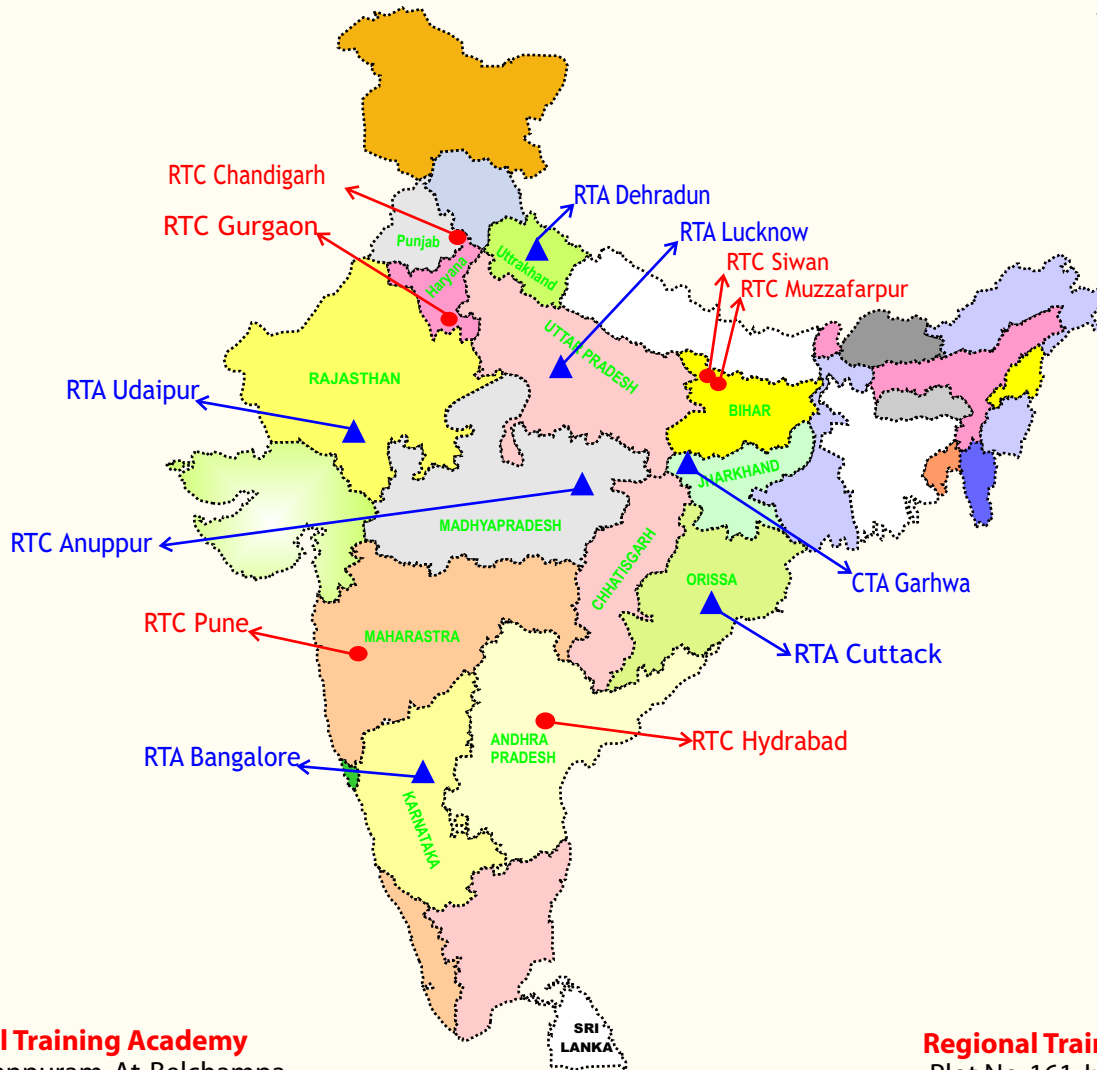

**T**he Security Officer (SO) in Security Operations is a pioneering specialized for professionals who wish to make a mark in the ever growing security business world. This is a training comprising of 06 months duration. During this period the trainees are required to complete academic training (theory & physical training) of 03 months and industrial training (On job training) of 03 months.

The curriculum of 03 months academic training has been designed to combine innovation with academic excellence. It offers trainees a diversified curriculum in specific areas and topics. A major focus is on learning through case studies, guest lectures, seminars, presentations, workshops on personality development

and industrial visit that would complement the classroom learning and enhance overall experience. A specific emphasis is therefore put on helping trainees to “learn how to learn”, i.e. motivating them to explore and discover new knowledge and practices thought to be useful for solving security problems and security operational issues. The participant growth is stimulated and they are encouraged for collective learning and support for the realization of each individual potential.

The three months industrial training is the practical application of the academic learning of three months. A report on the industrial training is to be submitted for evaluation.

## Eligibility Criteria

01. Education: Graduate & it's equivalent Degree in any stream
02. Age: 21 – 35 years as on 01 July of each year
03. Desirable: the medium of programmes will be English / Hindi proficiency in computers
04. Candidates having NCC 'C' certificate and outstanding sports achievements will be preferred.
05. Standard of Physical Fitness:
  - A. Height 170 cms (for females 160 cms), weight proportionate to height and age, Chest 80\_cms (+05 cms) with an expansion of 4 cms.
  - B. Far sight vision 6/6, near 0.6/0.6 with or without correction, free from colour blindness, should be able to identify and distinguish colour display in security equipments and read and understand display in English alphabets and Arabic numerals.
  - C. Free from knock knee and flat foot and should be able to run one Mile (1500 meters) in six minutes.
  - D. Hearing: Free from defect and should be able to hear and respond to the spoken voice and the alarms generated by security equipments.
  - E. The candidate should be free from evidence of any contagious or infectious disease. He/She should not be suffering from any disease which is likely to be aggravated by service or is likely to render him unfit for service or endanger the health of the public.

## Application Process

The filled-in application form with two passport size Photographs, Photocopies of Certificates of Educational Qualification, Extra Curricular Activities and Experience, if any, will be submitted at the written test centre on the date of written test.

Candidates are advised to satisfy themselves with the standards of physical parameters laid down before appearing in the selection test. They will be disqualified if not found up to the standard at the second phase of selection test during physical measurement which will be done at our examination centres.

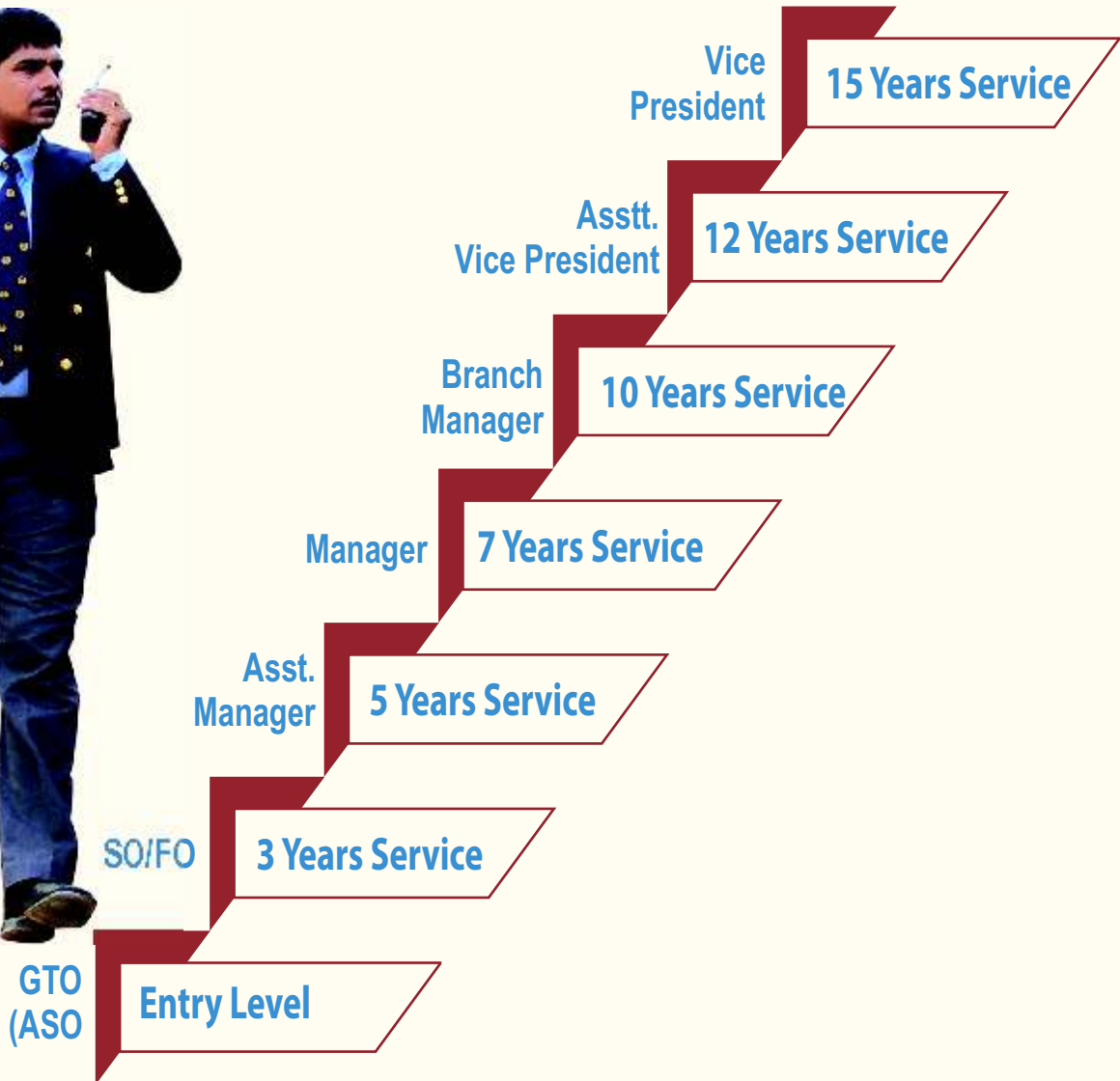
